- School hours are 8:30 am-3:30 pm. Students may enter the building at 8:15 am.
 - Class early release days are for teacher professional development hours required by the Dept. of Education. Classes will be dismissed at 1:30 pm on early release days. Childcare will be provided for children who are enrolled in our after-school program.
 - NH Dept. of Education requires 945 instructional hours for elementary school and 990 for middle and high school. This calendar reflects 968 hours for elementary school and 1,026 hours for middle and high school. Elementary grades have four days built in for inclement weather. Middle and high school have six extra days. Make-up days are therefore not necessary unless we exceed four days for inclement weather for elementary school and six days for middle and high school.
 - Parents must pre-register for vacation week camps and childcare. Registration information will be sent out prior to vacation weeks. No unregistered children will be accepted.
 - In the event of an inclement weather school closing, childcare will be offered, at an additional cost, providing that the center is opened.
 - In the event of a delayed opening, K-12 classes will begin at 10:00 AM. Before school care will not be available for class only students.
 - In the event of inclement weather, please check your Remind App or WMUR TV, www.wmur.com, (listed as 2nd Nature Academy) for delays and cancellations.
 - The school year is divided into trimesters for grades K-8. Report cards are issued 3 times per year. Tentative report card dates are: 11/20 and 3/12. The final report card will be mailed to the parents after last day of school.
 - The school year is divided into semesters for grades 9-12. Report cards are issued 2 times per year. Tentative report card date for semester one is: 1/22. The final report card will be mailed to the parents after last day of school.
